❖ Teaching Activities

This course will be jointly organised by the General Education Unit and the Centre on Behavioral Health. The instructors include Dr. Albert Chau, Director of General Education, and Professor Cecilia Chan, Director of the Centre on Behavioral Health and Ms. Celia Chan of the Centre of Behavioral Health. Students will go through a four-day workshop at which they will attend seminars and workshops. Students will be required to reside in one of the residential halls of the University. Students will be asked to submit a portfolio which includes a record of their learning activities and reflections, as well as a plan for what they plan to do for their further education.

❖ Award

A Certificate of Completion will be awarded to participants who are able to fulfill all the course requirements which include achieving an attendance rate of not less than **80%**. Students will be assessed mainly on their written work collected in their portfolio. **Students must complete all the assignments with satisfactory performance, participating actively in class and on time.**
